



Amar Seva Sangam established in 1981 has a 38 year legacy working towards rehabilitation, inclusive education and psychological support for children living with disabilities in Tamil Nadu. Over the past years, the organization has been recipients to multiple awards and has been recognized across forums for its contribution towards rehabilitating children living with disabilities.

Key achievements over the years:

- 900+ Villages adopted by the Sangam
- 3 Districts covered
- 40,733 children screened for Delayed Development
- 16000+ Disabled people benefitted through the Sangam
- 46995 persons with disabilities served in community programme
- 39,423 people with improved awareness on Child Development, Disability and Gender Rights
- 588 disabled gainfully got employed
- 4329 got skill development and vocational training
- 73 disabled students got higher education
- 4805 Self Help Group members

Amar Seva Sangam has been participating in the TATA Mumbai Marathon for three consecutive years. Support through multiple donors has helped the organization garner visibility at the marathon. This year, our endeavor is to raise funds for a new project on **Home Based Early Intervention for Children with Disabilities**.

## **Problem**

According to the WHO, “If children with development delays are not provided with appropriate early intervention, their difficulties can lead to lifetime consequences, increased poverty and profound exclusion.” Currently in Tamil Nadu, India, there are 1,02,600 children with disabilities in age 0-6. 85% of children have no access to EI therapy because of a lack of rehab specialists in rural areas and long distance to urban EI centers.

- Connect community workers with specialists through a mobile Village Based Rehabilitation (mVBRI) app

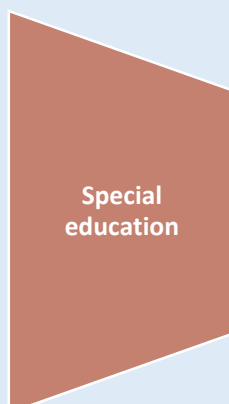

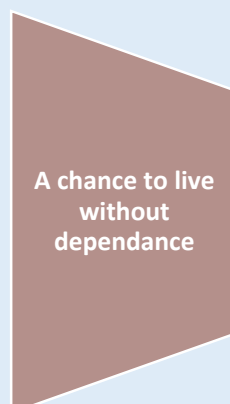
