SPEECH THERAPIST

NATURE & SCOPE OF JOB FOR THE SPEECH THERAPIST

The speech therapist works closely with infants, children and adults those who have various levels of speech and communication problems. The role can involve working with a diverse client group, including people with intellectual and learning disabilities, speech and hearing impaired, cerebral palsy and autism.

Therapists assess a client's needs before developing individual treatment programmes to enable each client to improve as much as possible. STs work as part of a multidisciplinary team, alongside other rehabilitation professionals like physiotherapists, occupational therapists, special educators, CBR workers and parents.

Expected roles and functions:

- Guide the workers to identify children's developmental speech and communication difficulties /disorders;
- Screening and assessing the children and adults having speech and communication difficulties;
- Devising, implementing and revising relevant treatment programmes;
- Monitoring and evaluating clients' progress;
- Guiding care givers on implementing treatment programmes and training other professionals in therapy delivery;
- Organise training program for the project staff, rehabilitation students and caretakers on speech and language development aspects.
- Contributing to the implementation and evaluation of projects and participating in research projects.
- Writing and maintaining client case notes and reports, as well as information for clients, care takers and other professionals;
- Liaising with rehabilitation professionals, government officials and other resource organisation for the development of the projects.

Bachelor degree (4 years) in speech therapy and relevant work experience in early intervention project is preferable.
